Bids for Clearing and Restoration on 108th Ave.

Vandenberg motion to approve the bid from Weick Bros Excavating \$52,303.00 as presented. Shannon seconded. Motion carried.

Flooding of 110th Ave. in Gainder Road

The Drain Commissioner explained to the public and board after she would receive a resolution from the Township board on behalf of the Township residents, she would hold public meetings to listen to all concerns from residents before she would approve or deny the resolution. At that time an engineer firm would be hired to determine the best solution to solve the problem. The final decision to move forward with the project would be left up to the Allegan County drain Commissioner.

Several people from the area spoke regarding concerns and solutions to fix the problem of flooding.

It was suggested that we dredged the pond on 110th or at least samples the pond to see if it would be beneficial to remove sediments that may be in the pond.

Dawn Roebuck request to be put on record as stating that the conditions worsened after the repaving of 110th Ave.

The board directed Vandenberg to contact our attorney to see if we can move forward with public funds regarding this flooding problem on 110th and Gainder Road. The board agreed to set a meeting in 90 days about or around September 26, 2018 a letter notice will be sent to those residents by supervisor Vandenberg.
