

**ORDINANCE NO. 167
AMENDMENT TO THE GUN PLAIN CHARTER TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE GUN PLAIN TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE FOR
THE PROPOSAL TO AMEND CHAPTER XXVI, SECTION 26.04, VIOLATIONS AND
PENALTIES:

GUN PLAIN TOWNSHIP, ALLEGAN COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

CHAPTER XXVI

SECTION 26.0 Violations and Penalties.

Amend Chapter XXVI, Section 26.04, Violations and Penalties, C. Penalties to read as follows:

Municipal Civil Infraction. A violation of this Ordinance is a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan statute and shall be punishable by a civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

	<u>Minimum Fine</u>	<u>Maximum Fine</u>
1 st Offense	\$75.00	\$500.00
2 nd Offense	\$150.00	\$500.00
3 rd Offense	\$325.00	\$500.00
4 th or More Offense	\$500.00	\$500.00

Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township has incurred in connection with the municipal civil infraction. In no case, however, shall costs of less than \$9.00 be ordered.

Amend Chapter XXVI, Section 26.04, Violations and Penalties, D. to read as follows:

D. Remedial Action. Any violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a basis for injunctive relief or other appropriate remedy in any court of competent jurisdiction to compel compliance with this Ordinance and enforce the provision thereof.

Delete Section 26.04, Violations and Penalties, E.

Change Section 26.04, Violations and Penalties, F to E and G to F
